Work "tryout" or internship

*Is the economy putting the squeeze on your business? If so, the Alabama Department of Rehabilitation Services (ADRS) may have a solution through our **READI-Net** (Resources for Employment and Disability Information Network).*

Through ADRS paid work experience or internship initiatives, you can reduce your recruiting, training, and staffing costs. These free, short-term incentives give you the opportunity to "try out" a job candidate as a potential hire with:

- Up to three months to "try out" a job candidate at your job site
- No obligation to hire the candidate
- No requirement to have an existing job vacancy
- Accident insurance coverage
- Salary paid by ADRS through a local community affiliate to the job candidate as a work incentive
- An opportunity to screen and train a potential hire
- Worksite accommodation assistance, if needed

Also, these incentives help a potential job candidate:

- Improve knowledge of your jobs and work culture
- Enhance knowledge, skills and abilities
- Increase competitiveness for future hire
