Providing Financial Loans for Assistive Technology

- Affordable
- Flexible
- Attainable





The Arizona Technology Access Program operates two statewide financial loan programs:


- AzLAT helps individuals with disabilities borrow money at affordable rates for the purchase of assistive technology.
- SEED Loan\$ provide affordable funding to persons with disabilities to purchase assistive technology and business equipment that supports self-employment, independent contracting, telework opportunities and working as an employee.

Qualified applicants (*persons who can demonstrate ability to repay the loan*) may be approved to borrow money in amounts ranging from \$500 to \$20,000. AzLAT offers many unique features which are not typically offered by traditional lending institutions. These include flexible repayment terms which may be beneficial to persons on fixed incomes, below market interest rates, and no prepayment penalties for early loan payoff.

Independence is priceless; we make it affordable

In addition, AzLAT staff members are available to provide:

- Assistance with completion of the loan application package
- Guidance/recommendations for selection of assistive technology devices
- Identification of other potential funding sources for assistive technology acquisition
- Assistance with identifying vendors
- Guidance on resolving credit report errors
- Intervention options to avoid loan default



Assistive Technology (AT) includes thousands of simple to complex devices and products that enable persons with disabilities to be more productive and independent in life activities such as

communicating, performing self-care tasks, managing a home, and improving mobility to enhance employment, education, participation in recreation and independent living.

Assistive technology may be used at home, in the workplace, in the classroom and in the community to provide creative solutions that reduce barriers and increase personal abilities.





Requirements

In order to be eligible for a loan, applicants (persons with disabilities or others on their behalf) must:

- Be current Arizona residents, living anywhere throughout the state.
- Be legally able to sign a contract for a loan.
- Demonstrate that the loan will be used to purchase assistive technology for a person with a disability.
- Demonstrate ability to repay the loan through sufficient monthly income and credit worthiness.
- Agree to have monthly payments directly debited from checking or savings account.
- SEED Loan applications for self-employment require a business plan and additional financial information.

AzLAT is currently able to make loans in amounts ranging from \$500 to \$20,000.

AzLAT loans can be used to pay for a wide variety of assistive technology devices and services.
